1. Identity of the data controller

In compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 (GDPR) and Spanish Organic Law 3/2018 of December 5 on Personal Data Protection and guarantee of digital rights (LOPDGDD), users of the website <https://enjoyadvisory.com> (the "Website") are informed of the following details of the data controller:

Enjoy Advisory has not appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), as this is not mandatory under article 34 of the LOPDGDD. Nevertheless, any query relating to the processing of personal data may be sent to the email address indicated above.

2. Data we collect and purposes of processing

Through the Website, Enjoy Advisory may collect and process the following personal data for the purposes indicated below.

a) Contact form and free consultation request

When the user completes the form available in the "Contact" section (name, surname, email address, telephone and message) or requests a free 30-minute consultation, we process these data in order to respond to requests for information, queries or collaboration proposals, manage the scheduling of the requested consultation or meeting, and carry out commercial follow-up of the pre-contractual relationship initiated by the user.

b) Newsletter subscription

When the user subscribes to the newsletter, we process their email address and, where applicable, name, in order to send periodic communications about news, content, strategies and sector trends, as well as information about events, webinars and activities organized by Enjoy Advisory.

c) Participation in events and webinars

If the user registers for an in-person or online event, such as a webinar, advertised on the Website, we process their contact details to manage the registration and facilitate access or attendance.

d) Browsing and cookies

While browsing the Website, data may be collected automatically through cookies and similar technologies for the purposes described in section 7 (Cookie Policy) of this document.

In all cases, fields marked as mandatory in the forms are necessary in order to respond to the relevant request. Failure to complete such fields will prevent the requested service from being provided.

3. Legal basis for processing

The processing of personal data is based, depending on the case, on the user's express consent, given by ticking the acceptance box for this Privacy Policy when submitting the contact form or subscribing to the newsletter (art. 6.1.a GDPR); the performance of pre-contractual measures taken at the request of the data subject when the request concerns the

contracting of consulting services (art. 6.1.b GDPR); and the controller's legitimate interest in managing the relationship with users who request information and in sending commercial communications related to services similar to those requested (art. 6.1.f GDPR), without prejudice to the user's right to object at any time.

4. Data retention period

Personal data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected.

Data provided through the contact form will be retained while the request is being managed and, subsequently, for the period necessary to address any liabilities arising from the processing.

Newsletter subscriber data will be retained until the user withdraws consent or requests cancellation of the subscription.

Data linked to the contracting of services will be retained for the duration of the relationship and, subsequently, for the applicable statutory limitation periods in legal, commercial, tax and accounting matters.

5. Recipients and processors

Enjoy Advisory does not transfer or disclose personal data to third parties except where legally required. However, for the proper provision of Website services, certain providers may access data as processors, including hosting and Website maintenance providers, form management, email and newsletter tools, web analytics providers where applicable, and video call or scheduling service providers for the management of free consultations.

Enjoy Advisory enters into the corresponding data processing agreements with all such providers as required by article 28 of the GDPR.

6. International data transfers

Some of the providers mentioned above may be located outside the European Economic Area, for example in the United States. In such cases, Enjoy Advisory ensures that the international transfer is covered by appropriate safeguards, such as European Commission adequacy decisions, standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission, or any other valid mechanism under Chapter V of the GDPR.

7. Cookie Policy

The Website may use first-party and third-party cookies, as well as similar technologies, for different purposes: technical or necessary cookies, which are essential for the proper operation and browsing of the Website and do not require consent; preference cookies, which remember information to personalize the browsing experience, such as language; analytics or measurement cookies, which quantify the number of visitors and analyze how users use the Website in order to improve content and services; and third-party cookies, such as social media cookies, where applicable, to allow interaction with content from networks such as LinkedIn.

Non-technical cookies will only be installed with the user's prior consent, which may be granted, rejected or configured when accessing the Website through the cookie settings panel, if available, and may be changed at any time.

The user may also configure their browser to block or delete installed cookies: Chrome: <chrome://settings/cookies>; Firefox: privacy and security options; Safari: privacy preferences; Edge: cookies and site permissions settings.

Note: at the time this document was prepared, the complete and updated technical list of cookies installed on the Website, including provider, duration and exact purpose, could not be exhaustively verified. 8. Rights of data subjects

Any person has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether Enjoy Advisory is processing personal data concerning them. Data subjects have the right to access their personal data, rectify inaccurate or incomplete data, request erasure of their data when, among other reasons, they are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, request restriction of processing, object to processing including profiling, request data portability, and withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent prior to withdrawal.

The data subject is also informed of their right to lodge a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency (AEPD), located at C/ Jorge Juan, 6, 28001 Madrid, or through its electronic office (www.aepd.es), especially where they have not obtained satisfaction in the exercise of their rights.

9. Security measures

Enjoy Advisory has adopted the technical and organizational measures necessary to guarantee the security and integrity of the personal data processed, and to prevent their alteration, loss, unauthorized processing or access, taking into account the state of the art, the nature of the data stored and the risks to which they are exposed.

10. Minors

Access to and use of the Website is intended for adults. Enjoy Advisory does not knowingly collect data from minors. If it becomes aware that data from a minor have been collected without the consent of their parents or legal guardians, such data will be deleted as soon as possible.

11. Accuracy and truthfulness of data

The user guarantees that the data provided to Enjoy Advisory are truthful and undertakes to communicate any modification thereof. In any case, the user will be responsible for the truthfulness of the data provided, and Enjoy Advisory reserves the right to exclude from its services any user who has provided false data.

12. Changes to this policy

Enjoy Advisory reserves the right to modify this Privacy Policy in order to adapt it to legislative, case-law or interpretative developments from the Spanish Data Protection Agency. In such cases, the changes introduced will be announced on the Website with reasonable notice before they are implemented.
